Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) Policy came into effect from 1.4.2010 for decontrolled P & K fertilizers (w.e.f. 1.5.2010 for SSP). As per this policy, fertilizers namely DAP, MOP, NPKS complexes, MAP, TSP, Ammonium Sulphate (AS) and Single Super Phosphate (SSP) are provided to farmers at subsidized rates based on nutrients (N, P, K & S) contained in these fertilizers. Additional subsidy is also provided on fertilizers fortified with secondary and micro nutrients as per the Fertilizer Control Order, such as Boron and Zinc.
