<p>Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers</p> <p>The main objective of this scheme is to support for equipment, machinery, infrastructure, research staff, etc.</p>	<p>Description</p> <p>This is a new Central scheme for creation of “Centres of Excellence” in the field of petrochemicals. The support under the scheme may include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Equipment2. Plant/machinery3. Building & infrastructure4. Support to research staff (JRF, SRF, RA through the project/ period)5. Research literature and consumables6. Organizing workshops/conferences/seminars in the relevant area

<p>Benefits:</p> <p>The funding of CoE will be in the form of capital expenditure. No recurring expenditure will be paid under this scheme. The percentage of financial support obtainable from the GoI out of the total investment/costs of the project will be a maximum of 50%, subject to an upper limit of Rs.6 crore over a period of three years.</p>

- Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS)

<p>Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers</p> <p>To supply critical fertilizers to farmers at subsidized rates, additional subsidy for fortifying with secondary and micro nutrients.</p>	<p>Description</p> <p>1. Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) Policy came into effect from 1.4.2010 for decontrolled P & K fertilizers (w.e.f. 1.5.2010 for SSP). As per this policy, fertilizers namely DAP, MOP, NPKS complexes, MAP, TSP, Ammonium Sulphate (AS) and Single Super Phosphate (SSP) are provided to farmers at subsidized rates based on nutrients (N, P, K & S) contained in these fertilizers. Additional subsidy is also provided on fertilizers fortified with secondary and micro nutrients as per the Fertilizer Control Order, such as Boron and Zinc.</p>
