The principle that good voluntary organizations should not only be assisted but also be consciously built up has been the guiding spirit behind the formulation of the scheme</p>
<p>Eligibility</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Those registered under Societies Registration Act or any relevant Act of the 2. State/Union Territory or 3. A public trust registered under law for time being in force or 4. A charitable company licensed under Section 25 of the Companies Act or 5. Indian Red Cross Society or its branches. Or 6.
